# **Treat Yourself to Fresh Mushroom Shares**

Elizabeth Almeida, owner of Fat Moon Farms in nearby Westford, MA provides WFCF with weekly shares of her fabulously fresh, locally grown, certified-organic mushrooms. Shares weigh a pound, with varieties varying week to week. You'll explore the flavors, textures, and colors of Shiitake, Oyster (which are blue, brown, black pearl, and yellow!), King trumpets, Lions mane, Chestnut, and Pioppino. Mushroom shares pair

well with WFCF vegetables, make discerning gifts for cooks, or a great treat for yourself! We offer two 10-week shares for \$178 each: <u>early share runs June 15-August 15</u> and <u>late share runs August 21-October 23</u>. The <u>full 20-week share</u> runs June 5-October 23 and is \$355.


